

This notice advises that, on April 30, 2025, the City of Markham received a complete Plan of Subdivision application for 4077, 4101 and 4121 Highway 7 E (the "Subject Lands") submitted by 2690622 Ontario Inc. c/o Macaulay Shiomi Howson, that meets the requirements to begin the City's review. **This notice is NOT an approval by the City of Markham**.

# The Property

The Subject Lands are approximately 4.92 ha (12.16 acres) in size and are located on the south side of Highway 7 East and generally east of Birchmount Road. 4077 and 4101 Highway 7 E consist of vacant lands (the former location of Sheridan Gardens) and a temporary sales center currently occupies the northern portion of 4121 Highway 7 E.

# The Applicant's Proposal

The Applicant proposes to withdraw their previous Draft Plan of Subdivision application and apply for a new Draft Plan of Subdivision under Bill 23. The general layout of the subdivision will remain relatively unchanged, and is comprised of four mixed-use development blocks, one park block, open space blocks, and future public roads.

### Please read this important information!

**Notice to Landlords:** If you are a landlord of lands containing seven (7) or more residential units, please post a copy of this notice in a location that is visible to all the residents.

**Personal Information:** Personal information collected in response to this planning notice will be used to assist City staff and Council to process this application and will be made public.

#### What if I want to appeal the proposal?

- i) If a person or public body would otherwise have an ability to appeal the decision of the Council of the City of Markham, or of the approval authority, to the Ontario Land Tribunal, but the person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting, if one is held, or make written submissions to the City of Markham in respect of the proposed plan of subdivision before the approval authority gives or refuses to give approval to the draft plan of subdivision, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision.
- ii) If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting, if one is held, or make written submissions to the City of Markham in respect of the proposed plan of subdivision before the approval authority gives or refuses to give approval to the draft plan of subdivision, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Land Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.

That means if this draft plan of subdivision is appealed to the Ontario Land Tribunal and you would like to participate in the appeal in some form, you **must** make an oral submission at a public meeting, if one is held, or submit written comments to the City Clerk, before the draft plan of subdivision is approved by Markham City Council.
