## Need help? Contact the City for these services:

### Green Bin Organics

Must weigh less than 18kg. Excess material must be in a clear bag placed beside the green bin.



All food scraps

Soiled paper



Diaper/adult briefs, feminine care products



Pet waste, kitty litter, fur



### Fats, Oil & Grease

Protect your pipes! Never pour fats, oils or grease down the sink, drain or toilet.

Pour or wipe it into your kitchen catcher.

### Clear Bag Garbage

CLEAR BAGS ONLY. NO dark, white, or blue bags.



Broken glass



Used furnace filters



Wooden/bamboo cutlery, stir sticks



Disposable masks, plastic gloves

### Bulky Items

Same day as clear bag garbage. Max. 3 items per collection.

#### Keep Your Collectors Safe!

- ✓ Place items neatly at the curb – do not stack.
- ✓ Keep items off snowbanks and the road.



#### Getting rid of a toilet?

2-piece toilets MUST have the tank separated from the bowl for the health and safety of our collectors.



#### Choose Reuse!

Items in good condition should always be donated to a local charity

### Yard Material

- Must weigh less than 18kg
- Same day as clear bag garbage (April to December)

**No grass clippings, soil or sod!**

## Electronics Recycling

**Know Before You Go!**

- Items must be fully intact
- Remove all batteries and packaging

**Protect Your Privacy - clear all personal information from items**



## Alkaline Batteries Only

- A, AA, AAA, C, D, 9V, button
- Reduce the risk of fire - store and drop off in a clear, plastic bag



## Scrap Metal Recycling

- Bicycles, microwaves, frying pan



## Textile Recycling

- All clean, unwanted clothing and textiles
- Including stained or damaged items
- 160+bins are located across the city



## Lithium-ion Batteries - Drop off at HHW Depot

- Cell phone, laptop, button, e-bike, power tools
- Cover terminal ends with tape
- Drop off regularly

## Every Container Counts!

- Wine, beer, spirit bottles and cans
- Keep out of the blue box
- Return your empty containers to a Beer Store for a cash refund
